

## **Instructions for authors wanting to publish their papers in ORBIS LINGUARUM**

ORBIS LINGUARUM publishes articles in the following languages: Polish, German, English and French. While formatting the text you should abide to norms customary in countries, in which these languages are official. In order of reliving our editors of some of their work, we would kindly ask you to adopt the following guide lines:

- Author's name – placed in the upper left corner, typeface Times New Roman, type size 12, bold
- Affiliation (city/name of institution) – placed in the upper left corner, under the author's name, Times New Roman 12, italics
- Title – middle spaced, Times New Roman 14, bold
- Main text – Times New Roman 12
- 1,5 space between lines
- The text should be justified and the paragraphs without indentation
- Publication languages: Polish, German, English and French
- Types of texts: academic papers, reviews, conference reports
- Topics: history of literature, foreign language teaching and literary didactics
- Article size: ca. 30 pages (60,000 signs with spaces)
- Review size: ca. 5 pages (10,000 signs with spaces)
- Notes: footnotes (preferential), numerated, Times New Roman 12, 1,0 space between lines, according to the norms customary in countries of its use
- References: bibliographical lists should be placed at the end of the article with the heading **Bibliography** – typeface Times New Roman, type size 12
- **ABSTRACT**: the article's title and the keywords in English (ca. 30 lines of text)
